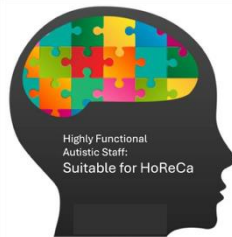

is an informal term used to describe individuals with average or above-average intelligence and mild support needs.

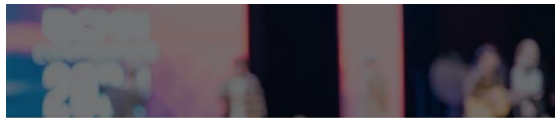
